ORDER

AND NOW, this 5th day of February, 2018, the Defendant having pled guilty to Amended Count I of the Criminal Information, Theft by Unlawful Taking, a felony of the third degree, it is the sentence of this Court that you, Dawn Stevens, be placed on Intermediate Punishment for a period of 1 year to be served on the Restrictive Intermediate Punishment Electronic Monitoring/House Arrest Program, and the Defendant shall pay a fee of \$10.00 per day payable monthly at the commencement of each month and pay the costs of these proceedings.

The Monroe County Probation Department shall obtain a DNA blood sample and fingerprints from the Defendant pursuant to Act 185 of 2004, and the Defendant shall pay the \$250.00 fee associated therewith.

The Defendant's period of Intermediate Punishment shall be followed by a period of 4 years probation.

The Defendant shall complete 100 hours of community service for each and every year that she is

under supervision.


The Defendant shall pay \$27,000.00 in restitution to St. Luke's Parish on a payment plan of \$250.00 per month for each month she is on Electronic Monitoring and \$500.00 per month for each month that she is on probation.

The Defendant's probation shall be under and subject to the rules and regulations of the Monroe County Probation Department which shall include the payment of a \$35.00 per month supervisory fee in accordance with Act 35 of 1991.

As a specific condition of this sentence, the Defendant shall not engage in any gaming or gambling whether on site or via the Internet or any other electronic means.

Upon motion of the attorney for the Commonwealth in open court pursuant to Pa.R.C.P. Rule 585, all open charges listed in the criminal information are nolle prossed.
