ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

AND NOW, this 27th day of May, 2021, We Order and Declare as follows:

By Order dated May 20, 2021 the Pennsylvania Supreme Court has designated June 18, 2021 as a special holiday and Ordered all Courts of the Unified Judicial System closed other than for essential functions or other proceedings deemed necessary by the President Judge; and

On June 19, 2019 the Governor of Pennsylvania signed legislation designating Juneteenth as an annual day of observance in the Commonwealth, recognizing the day as one of great historical and cultural significance, the commemoration of which serves as occasion to promote the advancement of unity, equality and justice for all Pennsylvanians. This year the Governor has designated June 18, 2021 as a special holiday for all employees under the Governor's jurisdiction; therefore,

In accordance with the order of the Pennsylvania Supreme Court and in observance of the day of commemoration recognized by our Governor and Legislature, all Courts of the 43rd Judicial District, Monroe County, Pennsylvania shall be CLOSED on June 18, 2021, except for the EMERGENCY matters listed on Attachment A. All emergency matters shall be filed in person or electronically and shall be heard by Advanced Communication Technology in accordance with this Court's procedures and protocols established by prior orders of this Court during the COVID19 Judicial Emergency. The orders and protocols are available on the Court's website at www.monroepacourts.us. The District Court Administrator shall arrange adequate remote coverage for those matters delineated in attachment A. All proceedings scheduled for June 18, 2021, not designated in this order as emergencies, including jury selection, are continued to a date and time to be determined by Court Administration or each assigned Judge.
